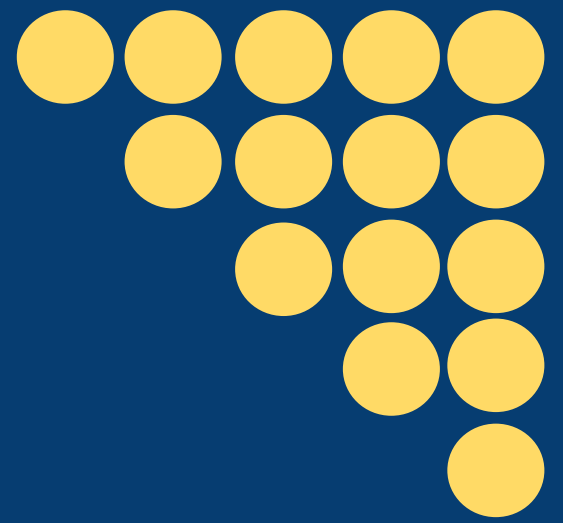

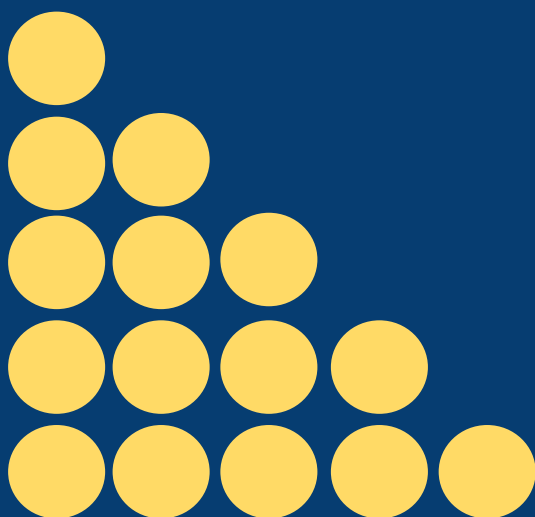

Message

from the President

Greetings Fellow Auxiliary Members:

Thank you for your support and confidence during my reign as the 84th President of the ANMA, of which I have been a member since 1983.
